

Bellingham Bells Public Address Announcer (Summer 2018)

The public address announcer is a part-time, seasonal position, working on the days of 2018 home games. The public address announcer's responsibilities will include, but not be limited to:

- Working with Bellingham Bells promotion staff to execute a nightly script that may include player announcements, PA reads, inning promotion commentary & other in-game promotions.
- Coordinate with broadcast staff to receive lineups, rosters and any in-game substitutions, and be able to clearly and correct announce player names, positions & universities.
- Manage music and sounds throughout the game, working with the Bells' front office staff to determine an appropriate playlist for a family-friendly environment.
- Other tasks as related to public address announcing as assigned by the Bells' front office.
- Reports directly to Bells' general manager.

Minimum Required Qualifications

- At least one year experience working in radio, public address announcing or similar setting.

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with public address announcing in an athletic setting
- Experience with music management software
